Consider the Power of...

- ... **One** new Bible Study Group/Sunday School Class. New classes/groups:
 - Reach more people than existing classes/groups
 - Tend to be more inviting than existing classes/groups
 - Grow faster than existing classes/groups

Consider the Power of...

- ... **One** Connect Group/Care Group per Bible Study Group/Sunday School Class. They:
 - Give intentionality to ministry
 - Give intentionality to outreach
 - Create an atmosphere of concern

Consider the Power of...

- ... **One** Church stepping into its community. Stepping into the community:
 - Fulfills Jesus' command to "Go" and make disciples
 - Demonstrates the church's concern for its community
 - Opens doors for future ministry

Consider the Power of...

- ... **One** invitation to attend church. Most unchurched people, according to The Unchurched Next Door:
 - Feel guilty about not attending church
 - Are "somewhat likely" to attend church if invited
 - Have a positive view of pastors, ministers and the church

Consider the Power of...

- ... **One** Christian connecting with a lost person in order to help them come to Christ. Research shows that the majority of unsaved persons:
 - Would like to develop a real and sincere relationship with a Christian
 - Have never had someone share with them how to become a Christian
 - Would rather talk about religious matters with a lay person than a minister

Consider the Power of...

- ... **One** Gospel Presentation. Thom Rainer has discovered that many unchurched individuals:
 - Believe in the existence of both heaven and hell
 - Would accept Christ as Savior if presented with the Gospel (17 million)
 - Are nervous, but willing, to talk about matters of faith
